

Regular Maintenance

Using mild soap or detergent, machine wash on synthetic setting with a high water level and mild agitation. Temperature should not exceed 160°F. Extract gently. Wash with like materials.

If necessary, machine wash with a diluted bleach solution. This textile may also be spot cleaned with a diluted bleach solution as long as the bleach solution is rinsed thoroughly after application. If bleach is used without adequate rinsing, degradation to the textile will occur.

Air, cabinet, or tumble dry at a low temperature. Do not exceed 3-5 minutes on a synthetic cycle at a maximum of 140°F. Hang or fold immediately after drying.

Hand Iron

Iron at low heat setting (275°F) with a damp press cloth or steam iron with a dry press cloth.

Grid Head Press

Press for short intervals with minimum steam. Do not lock head.

Flat Bed Press

Press dampened drapery using cloth covering.

Avoid prolonged contact with heat.
