As defined by OSHA Standards for General Industry an "Article" is a "manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical, and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees".

As some textiles can release more than a minute or trace amount of a hazardous chemical or pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees, SDS sheets are available by request.
